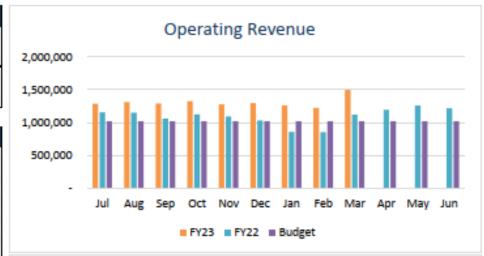

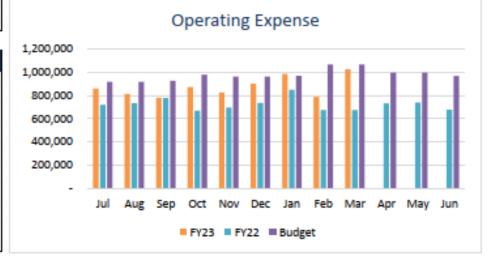

#### Revenue Expense

March passenger numbers improved over greatly over February, up 30%.

The increased passenger numbers translated into higher revenue across all major revenue categories.

Salaries/Benefits - ILM had three open positions during the month of March; staff continues to work to fill those positions.

Contracted sessorices - includes NHCSO service and parking lot management and consultants. Awaiting a few consulting invoices that will put this expense more in line with the budgeted figure.

Repairs and Maintenance - includes \$58k of airfield painting. This figure is well below the budgeted amount for the year.

Adverstising/Marketing - the monthly amount reflects new televison and radio campaigns that started in March.

Insurance - policies finalized after budget approval; may need to amend budget.

Other - includes equipment leasing, conference expense, and air service

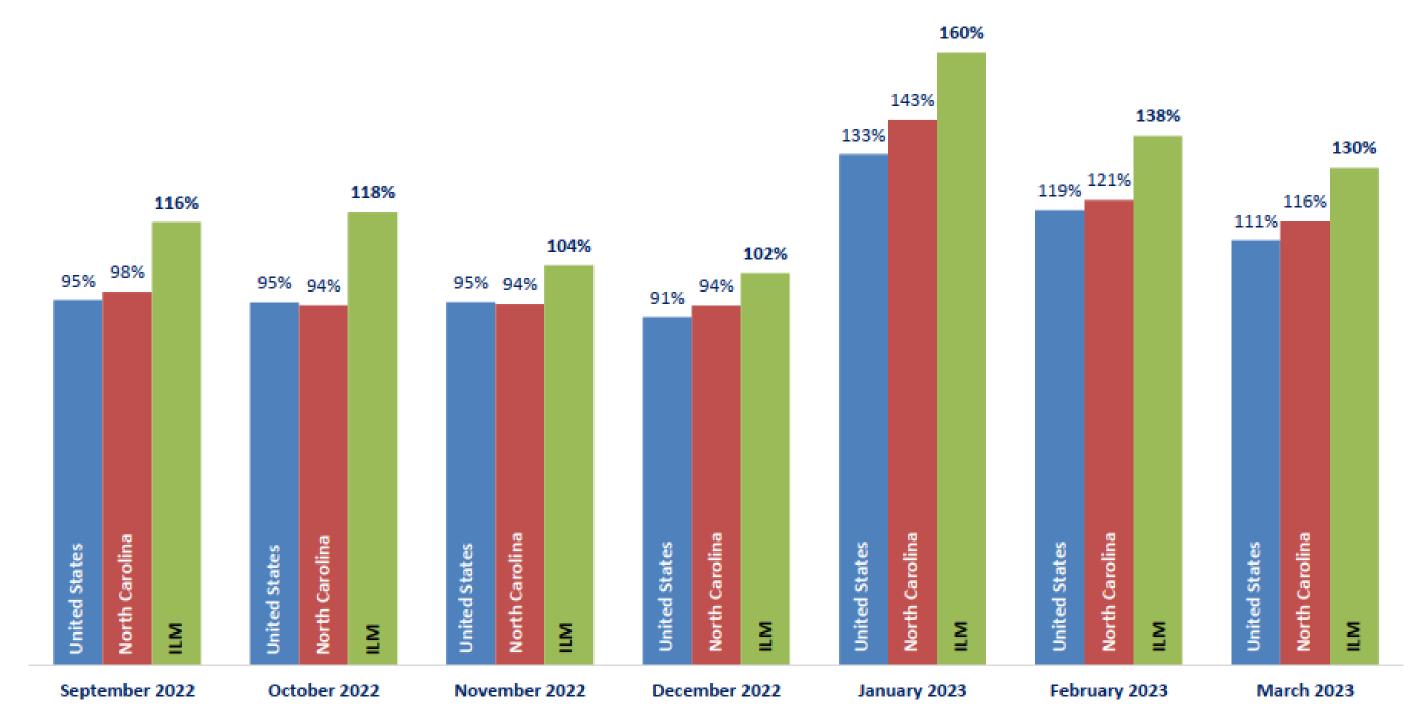

#### MONTHLY PASSENGER ENPLANEMENTS 2019 - 2023

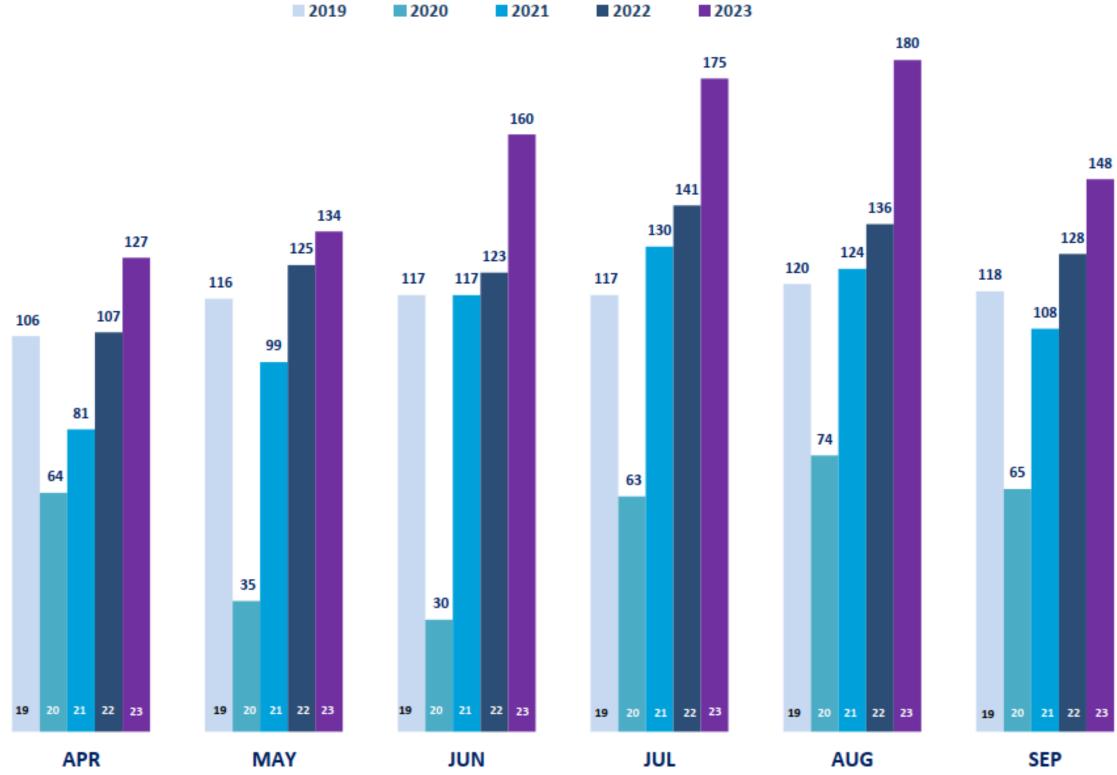

#### SEAT CAPACITY April - September 2019-2023

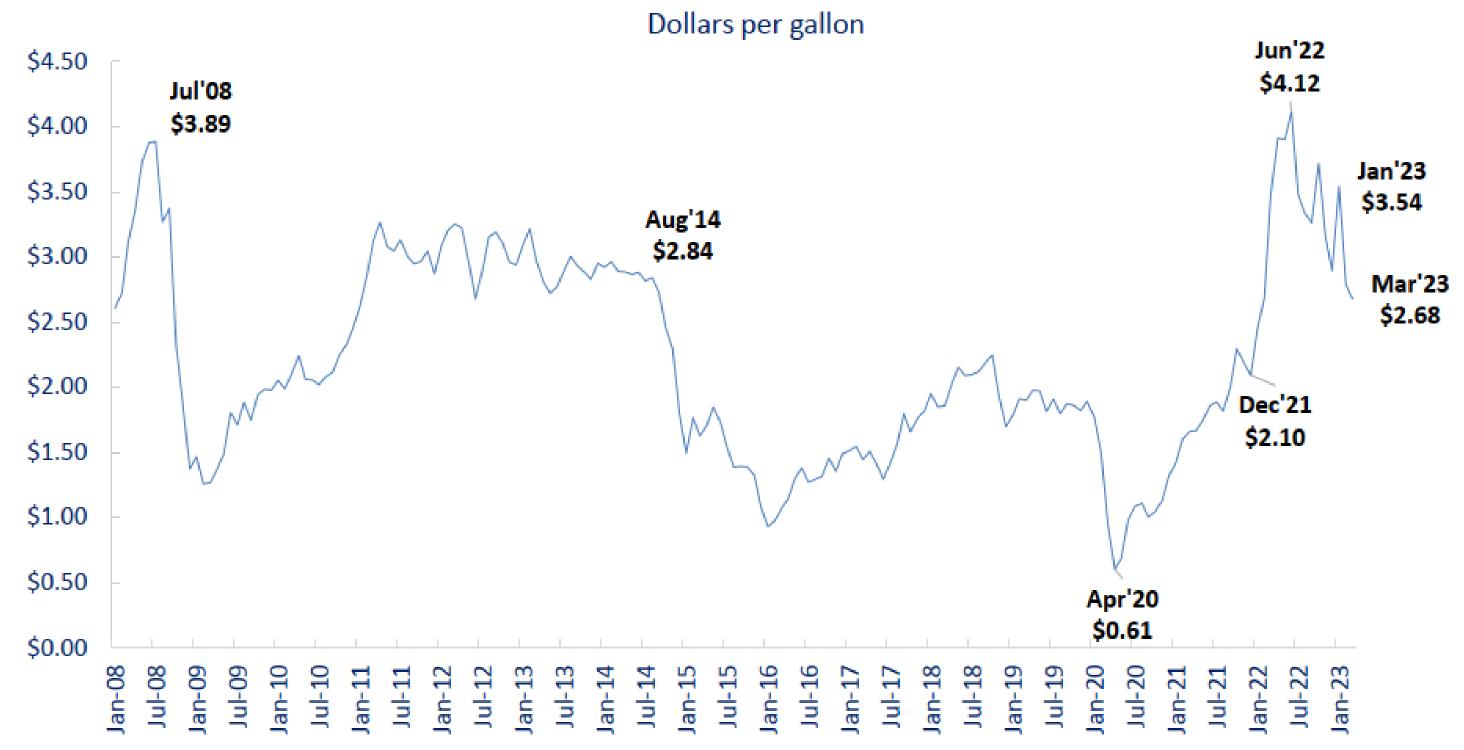

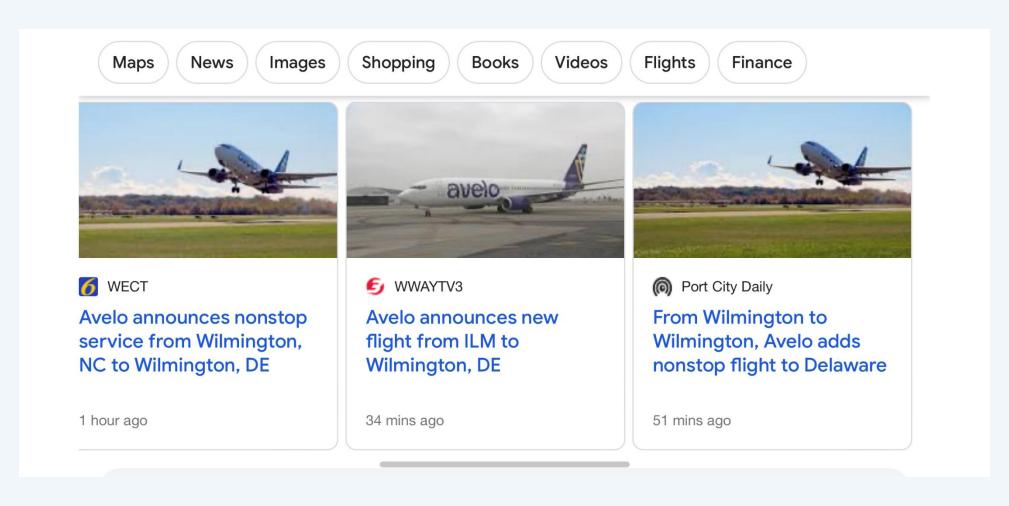

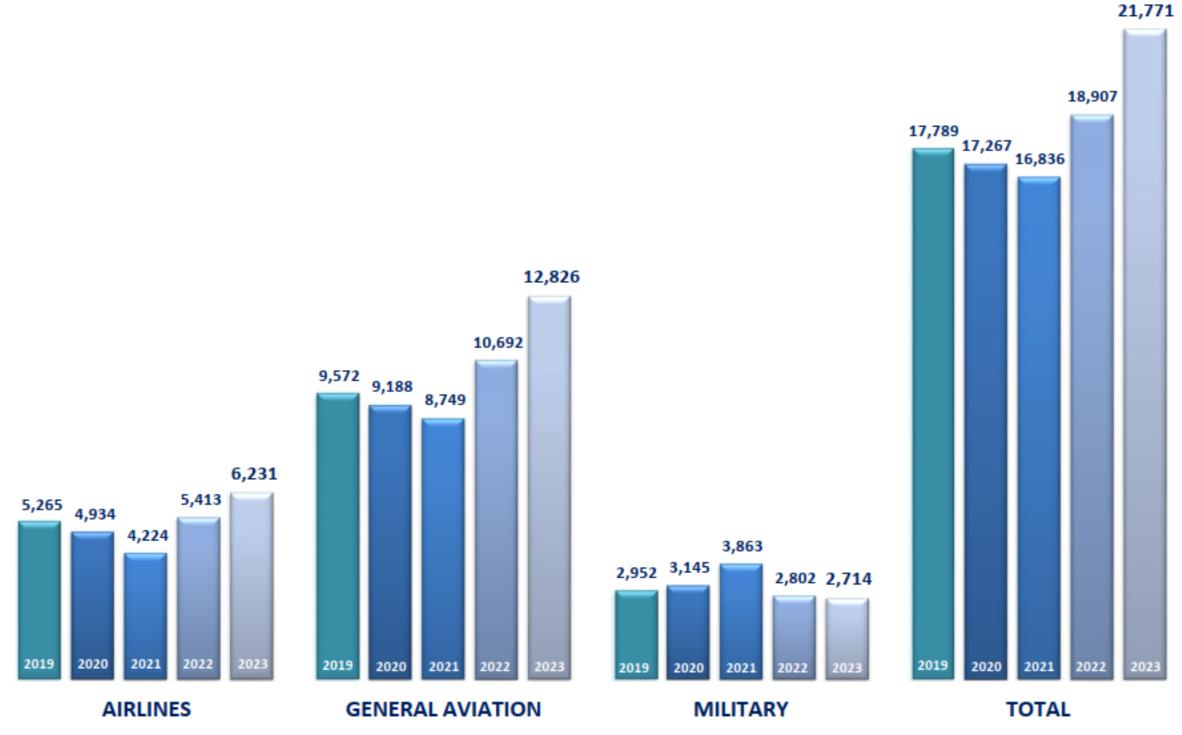




## AIRPORT OPERATIONS JANUARY-MARCH

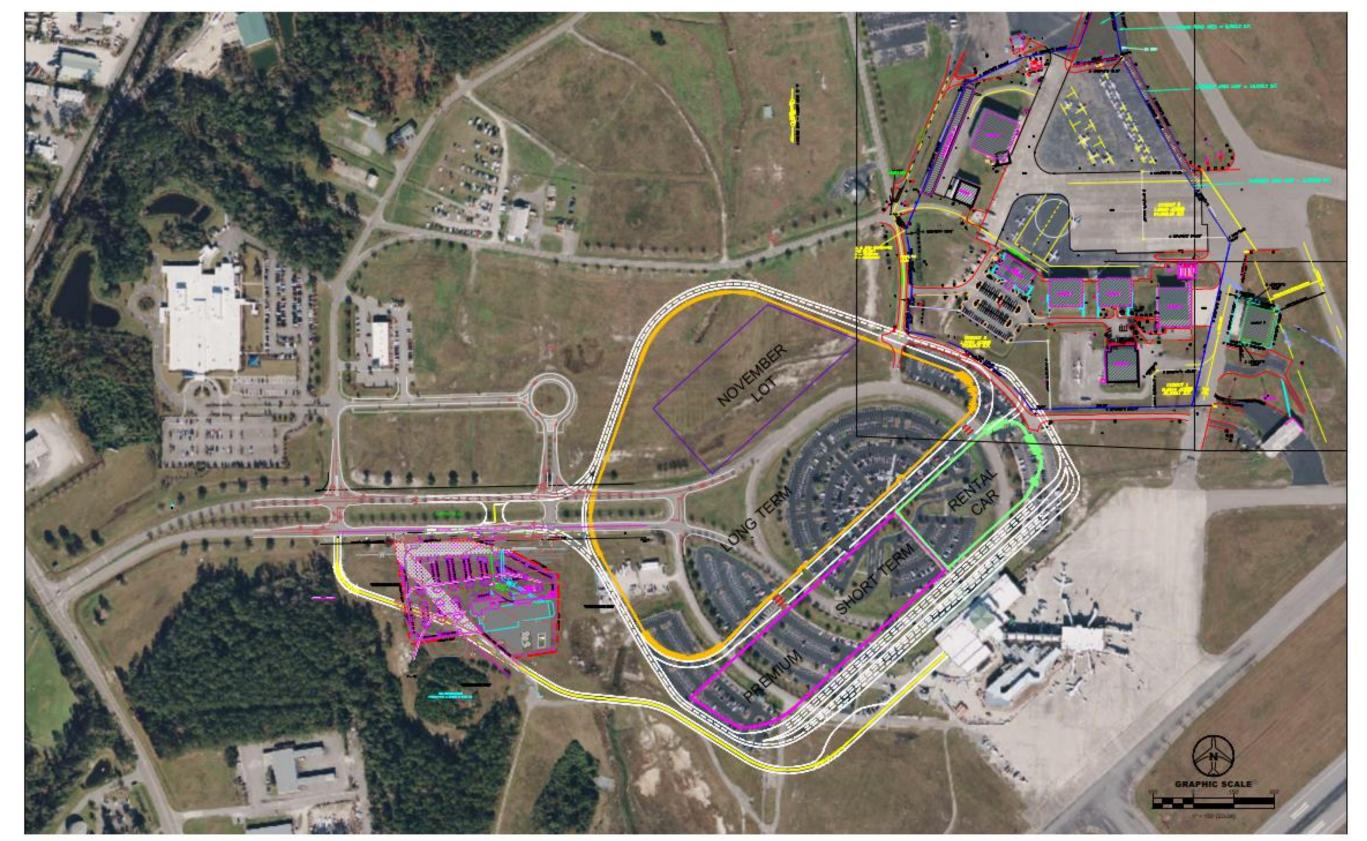

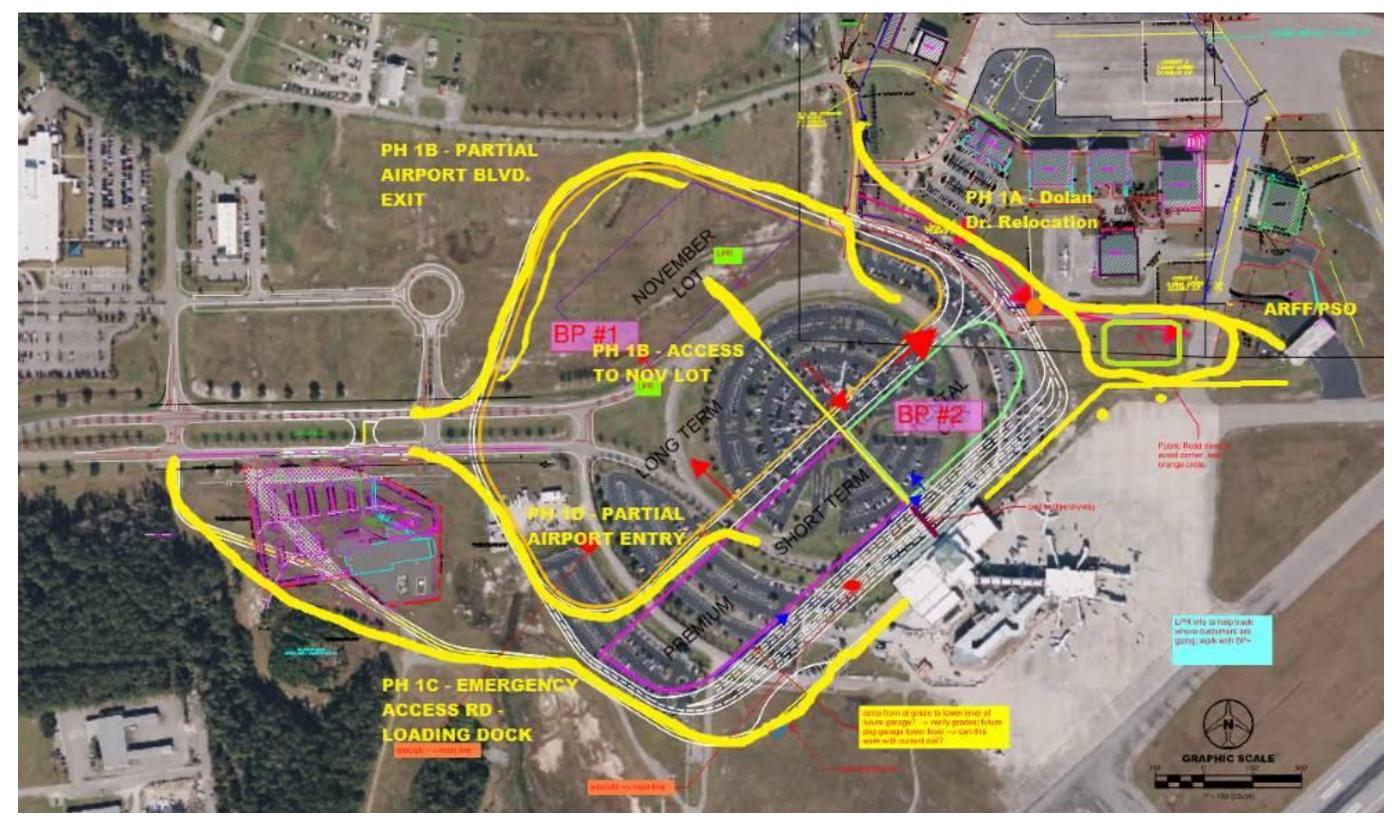
