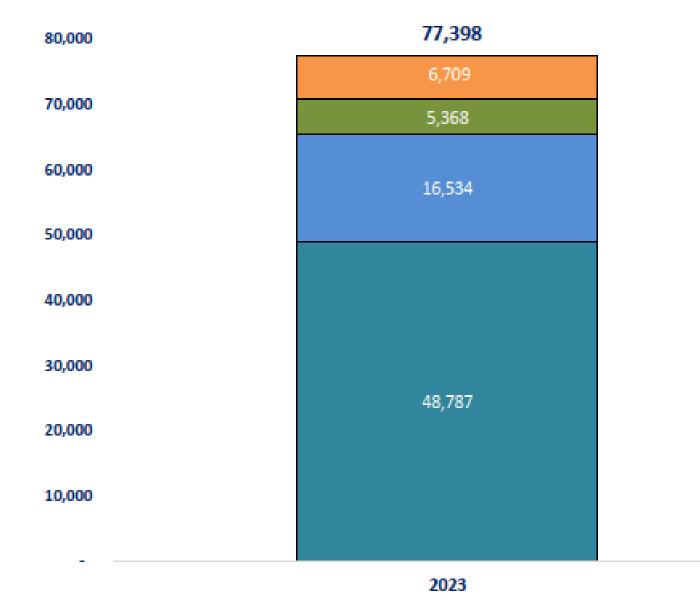
ENPLANED PASSENGERS BY AIRLINE

JANUARY-FEBRUARY

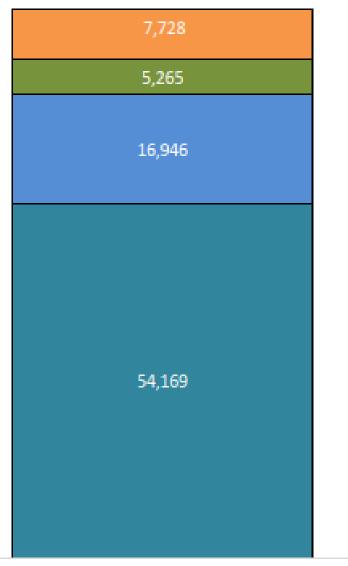

MONTHLY PASSENGER ENPLANEMENTS 2019 - 2022 - 2023 - 2024

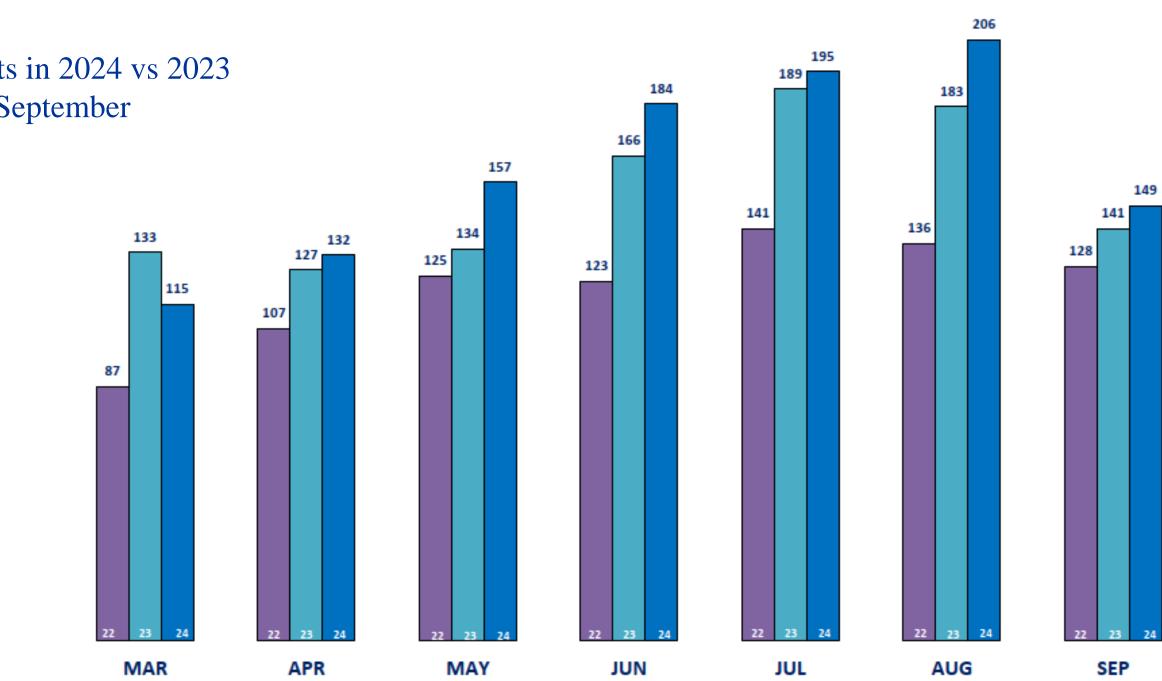

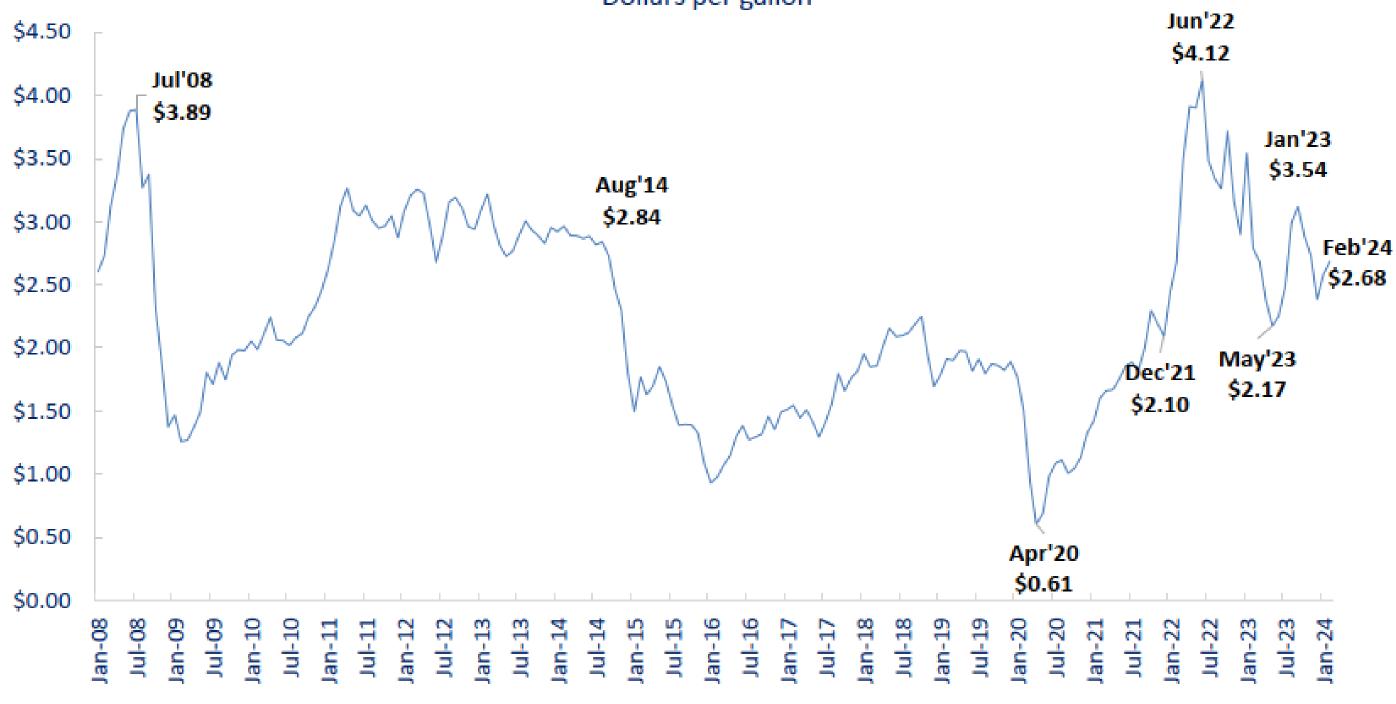

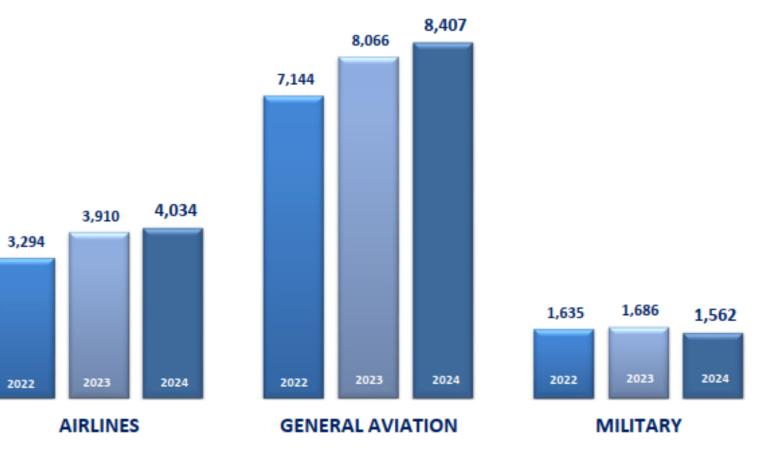
